Dear Secretary Buttigieg:

We strongly support the grant application from the States of California, Oregon and Washington for \$700 million for the West Coast Truck Charging and Fueling Corridor Project through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law's Charging and Fueling Infrastructure program.

This multistate project will support early deployment of infrastructure for zero-emission trucks along the major freight centers across California to Washington. This first-of-its-kind project will create a network of charging and hydrogen fueling stations and enable zero-emission trucking from Mexico to Canada, linking ports and major freight centers in California, Oregon and Washington.

The project will play a critical role in alleviating significant air pollution and global warming emissions associated with medium- and heavy-duty vehicles. The cities and regions that will benefit from this project constitute the majority of the most polluted areas in the United States, based on the major categories of air pollution tracked by the American Lung Association.

This project will further support key policy actions in California, Oregon and Washington that require the sale of zero-emission trucks beginning in model year 2024. This investment will be critical to scaling the zero-emission truck industry and job creation expected with this transition.

The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) is creating transformational improvements to our nation's transportation systems to increase transportation safety, decrease emissions and improve the local health of our constituents. The West Coast Truck Charging and Fueling Corridor Project is an important tri-state initiative to achieve these outcomes.
