Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for The City of Farmersville's Streetlamp Project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Farmersville located at 909 W. Visalia Road, Farmersville, CA 93223. The funding will enable the city to install roughly 70 streetlights.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because The City of Farmersville has a significant gap in the frequency with which its streetlights are placed, due to the lights previously being owned by the County. Unfortunately, this has created a significant public safety issue where both pedestrians and drivers are forced to travel long distances in pitch black. Both traffic safety and general crime are more likely to occur in the dark conditions across many neighborhoods in Farmersville.

This project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1) of the United States Code.
